Parish Church – During 2018 we completed work on three windows on the South side of the church. There are plans to start the small stained glass window on the South side and the large stained glass East window in the spring, as soon as weather allows. This has been possible because of the generous donations we have received and the proceeds of the fundraising events held during the year.

We have been so grateful for the generous support shown by other village organisations and the people of Boddington and are conscious that we did hold a lot of events last year. We still need to raise about £20,000 to enable us to fund repairs to all the windows and hope to do this by organising a few events and making more applications for grants from various bodies.

In addition to raising money for the windows the usual work of the church went on, and as well as trying to cover the day to day running costs we were able to give over £700 to other charities from collections at special services. The generous donations to the food banks, which are collected in church, also continued.

Battles Over Event - I would like to thank everyone who contributed to the success of the Battles Over Event on 11th November to commemorate the ending of World War 1.

Thanks to everyone who contributed cakes for the School's vintage tea or helped make and distribute the sandwiches and drinks.
